Grants from 200,000 yen to 500,000 yen will be awarded for projects to be conducted from April 1<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup> the following year.

### **Application Process**

Application should be made with a form specified by The Foundation and should include the following:

- Applicant name
- Project outline and budget
- Reference materials about Applicant's past activities
- Letter of recommendation including the recommender's name and title.

# **Selection Process**

Screened by the Selection Committee and approved by the Foundation Board sometime around mid-March.
